

Leavenworth OMS/UHS Building



The 3,200 square foot storage and maintenance building will serve the Army Reserve in Leavenworth, KS. The building provides unheated storage area, vehicle maintenance, flammable storage, controlled waste storage, office space and rest rooms. The structure is conventional CMU bearing walls with brick wainscot, upper metal wall panels and standing seam metal roof.

The storage and maintenance building is a support building for the Army Reserve Center being designed simultaneously. The ARC building is approximately 40,000 square foot with a construction cost of \$8,000,000. The two buildings are similar; however, the ARC building is two story, conditioned office and training space.
